- 1. The group was officially recognised as a Charity for tax purposes by H M Revenue & Customs on 22<sup>nd</sup>. June 2011. (Registered with OSCAR 24/8/2010)
- 2. No grants have been paid out during the period covered by the accounts.
- 3. No remuneration has been paid to any Trustee or to any other person
- 4. There are no other transactions to report between the Charity and its Trustees or any other person.
- 5. Edinburgh & Lothian Prostate Cancer Support Group has received, with grateful thanks, several donations during the period. Full details of individual donations are recorded on the donations section on the Group's website. Some donations are also received via Virgin Money Giving The total amount received during the year inclusive of Gift Aid and net of expenses was £637.71 of which £131.46 was via Virgin Money Giving.

- 6. Pre Covid the Group held regular members' meetings both in Edinburgh and Livingston. Face to face meetings were not possible during 20/21 because of the pandemic. The total admin expenses were £725.74 (£3107.37 in the previous year) these admin expenses include, telephone, postage, stationery, photocopy charges, advertising, CD's provided to the Western General for patient consultations etc. No rent is payable.
